

IMPORTANT GENERAL INFORMATION

FISHING:

- It is very important to contact our office at 907-262-0892 the night prior to each of your fishing trips between 5:00 – 7:00 PM. We create the following days fishing schedule based on current fishing conditions and regulations, so please make sure you check in so we can provide you with a meet time and locations as to where you will meet your guide. We reserve the right to alter any package or itinerary as fishing regulations or existing conditions may require. In addition, the duration of your fishing trips for any species may be shorter if and when a limit is achieved. Unless noted in your daily itinerary, please contact us between 5:00-7:00 PM to confirm or re-confirm schedules for the following day.
- You are responsible for purchasing a fishing license and king stamp (if king fishing between May – July). We recommend waiting to purchase your fishing license when you arrive. You can view daily and weekly rates in addition to purchasing your fishing license prior to your arrival at the State of Alaska Department of Fish and Game website <https://www.adfg.alaska.gov/index.cfm?adfg=license.fgstore> or at any of the local service stations or grocery stores. Children under 16 do not need a license, but do need a harvest ticket, which is available at no charge wherever licenses are sold.
- You are responsible for packing your lunch. We provide light snacks, coffee and water on your guided river trips.
- Your fishing charters are considered a “service” as it would be if you were in a restaurant. Tipping (10-20%) is customary as much as it is appreciated by your guide. You will not necessarily have the same guide for each of your fishing trips, so we recommend tipping after each daily service.
- If you are unable to contact us the night prior to your trip between the designated time on your daily itinerary, please let us know well before you arrive in state so we can help make alternative arrangements to confirm your meet time and boat launch instruction.
- Please do everything possible to avoid checking past 8:00 PM the night prior to your trip as we retire early in order to receive adequate rest for the next day.

LODGING:

Arrival:

- Standard check in time is 3:00 PM, unless specifically noted on your daily itinerary.
- A map or written instructions to your cabin is included with this confirmation package. PLEASE place this in a secure place and have it available when you arrive. You will need this information to locate your cabin.
- Upon arrival, you will check yourself into your cabin. Each unit has specific instructions for a self-check in so please refer to your daily itinerary or Short Term Rental Agreement.
- There are parking signs for each individual cabin. If you are not sure where to park, do not hesitate to ask and we can redirect you.

Departure:

- Standard check out time is 11:00 AM, unless specifically noted on your daily itinerary.
- If you have an activity planned on the same day you are scheduled to check out, please gather your belongings and take them with you when you depart.
